Visiting Portland, Dorset, UK

Portland lies at the heart of the Jurassic Coast, a World Heritage Site covering 185 million years of history from 250 million years ago to 65 million years ago.

Part of the Mesozoic Era, it contains the Triassic, Jurassic and Cretaceous periods.

There are many things to do and see on your visit to this area. To the West, there is Lyme Regis where Mary Anning found the first fossil, Abbotsbury with its famous Swannery and the Sub-tropical Gardens which are alongside on the unique Chesil Beach, and Golden Cap, the highest point on the south coast of the UK.

To the east lies Corfe Castle, a ruin from medieval times, Swanage, a picturesque Victorian town, Kimmeridge, one of the best places to find evidence of fossils and the iconic Lulworth Cove and Durdle Door.

These are just a few of the things which can really enhance your Jurassic Coast experience. There are great walks in all directions (this area is part of the 1000 Km/630 Mile South West Coast Path), historic houses, classic Dorset villages and pubs, Stonehenge is only 100 Km/60 miles away.
